Dear Parent/Carer,

As an exciting part of our 'Thrills & Spills' topic next half term, we have arranged a visit for year 5 and 6 children to go to the Black Country Museum to take part in their 'Funky Fairground' workshops. **Year 5** classes will be going together on **Wednesday 5th December 2018**. **Year 6** classes will be going together on **Thursday 6th December**. The trip will give the children a great opportunity to enhance their understanding of the history of the fairground and the mechanics of fairground rides. Payment costs are now live on Parent Pay, you should have received a notification, if you haven't please come and speak to a member of the School Office staff. This cost includes coach travel to the Black Country museum, entrance fees to the centre and a Black Country museum staff led workshop.

On the day your child will need:

- a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks or yoghurts please)
- a bottle of water which can be resealed to drink throughout the day
- a rucksack to carry their lunch, drink, sun cream etc in
- school uniform preferably with the school logo if possible
- a waterproof coat and sensible footwear

If you need support with the cost of the trip please speak to Mr Poole in confidence. If insufficient payments are received we are unable to finance the trip, all monies paid by parents will be refunded.

We will be aiming to leave school at **8.00am**. Please ensure your child has entered school through the Beech Lane main entrance by **7:50am at the latest**, so we can register the children and set off promptly. The main entrance will be open from 7:35am. We will hopefully return to school by **3.25 p.m**. In the event of traffic delays, we will keep you informed via text/twitter.
