Dear Parents/Carers,

It's really hard to believe that we have once again arrived at December and Advent is just about to start meaning that we are well and truly on the countdown to Christmas. It will be lovely to see many of you in school over the next few weeks watching nativities, going to fayres and generally getting in a festive mood. I trust that whatever you are doing this Christmas that you will have a safe and enjoyable time.

Term time Holidays

I have been asked on a number of occasions to explain to people what the school's policy on term time holiday is. In short, the school's policy is that we don't authorise any term time holiday (in line with the government's stance) because of the proved detrimental effect that such holidays have on the education of our pupils.

However, I am aware that there are some exceptional circumstances that mean that term time holiday has to be taken and, in these cases, the holiday is authorised. Our definition of exceptional circumstances can include, an absence that is related to a death or a wedding of a close family member. In some cases, these will involve travelling to and from the event and this will also be authorised. Other requests deemed exceptional could include a holiday that includes a father or mother who is currently a member of the armed forces or one related to a family member who is terminally ill.

Please note that any other term time holiday is unlikely to be authorised even if it is linked to an occupation where holidays are limited or have to be taken at certain times.

In some cases, where a term time holiday is not authorised, a penalty notice may also be issued which ultimately leads to parents being fined. Scargill governors have discussed this and feel that if the following three criteria are all met then a penalty notice will be issued.

- 1. The requested holiday is not the first unauthorised holiday for the pupil.
- 2. The requested holiday is longer than two school days.

3. The pupil's attendance is below the National average (to the nearest percentage point) of 96.0%. This attendance rate will be taken for the current academic year if the holiday is requested after Christmas. If the holiday is requested before Christmas, then the percentage will be taken for the whole of the previous academic year.

Please feel free to talk with Mrs Page in the office (or myself) about any of these points. I hope that this provides clarity into how we deal with such requests at Scargill.
