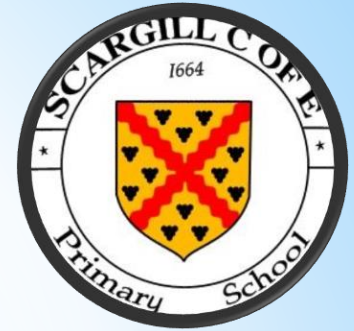
BUT ... We need to accept the report and address all issues no matter how we feel about it. This is the only way for the school to really improve.

Is there any impact on pupils?

- * Pupils will undoubtedly be upset.
- * Staff who work with them will feel hard done by.

...BUT...

- * Extra support will help staff to improve.
- * Consequently, pupils at Scargill will have the very best opportunities because of this support and increased scrutiny.

What does this mean?



- * Academisation.
- * Action Plan jointly authored by LA and DDAT.
- * Support for improvement from external agencies.
- * No NQTs and limitations on training students.
- * Upon academisation we become a school without an official OFSTED judgement.
- * Re-inspection within three years.



What support will be given to the school?

- * Full safeguarding Audit.
- * Full audit of Pupil Premium funding.
- * Full review of PSHE and how Anti-Bullying sits within this.
- * Support for middle leaders to become even more effective.
- * Full review of governance.
- * Support for Teaching and Learning including 'Mastery in Maths'.

Things already in place



- * Improved paperwork to support our current practice regarding bullying.
- * Review of policies and procedures and a plan for a complete overhaul in the next year.
- * Greater departmental scrutiny
 - * Looking in books
 - * Learning walks
 - * Pupil voice
