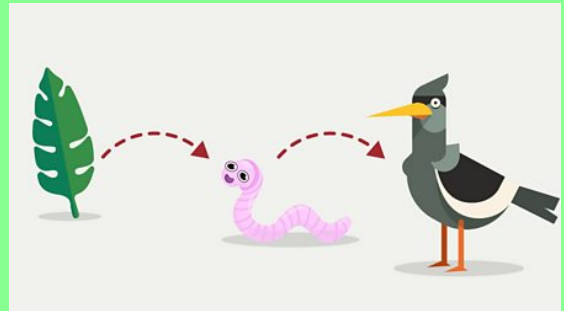

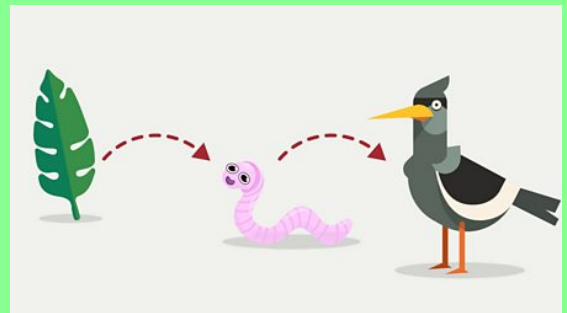

Which types of organism will the rest of the food chain contain?



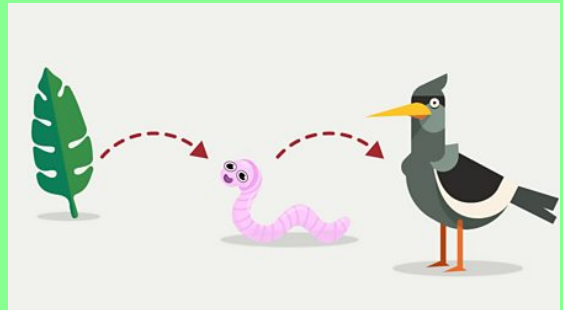
The Food Chain Game

Cut out the squares and make as many food chains as possible.

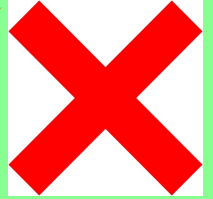
Main Activity
