WALT: find out about a story for a newspaper report

Using the work you did last week, we'd like you to plan the details for a newspaper report of your own.

For the story, you could choose an **existing story in the news** (e.g. all children going back to school next week) or you could choose a **different** one of the ideas we used last week (see below).

A local person has won 3 million pounds on the lottery and plans to donate some to charity.	A local football team have been promoted up to a higher league, to the delight of their fans
A dog rescued a young boy from being stuck in a hole by alerting his parents and calling for help.	A young girl has discovered a fossil which scientists say is from a previously undiscovered type of din

Today, you need to begin to research (or make up!) the details for your story and fill in the newspaper planning grid. You'll need quotes from those involved, the 5Ws for your story, background details and what might happen next- the more detail you put in your planning the better your final report will be!
