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Dear Parents,

We thought it would be useful to send a letter to remind you of a few things necessary for the Lea Green residential which is coming up very soon.

Please name items as we can get a lot of lost property and we would like to send children home with everything they came with!

It is important that children do not bring items of value or electrical equipment and they do not need to bring any food or money.

Please let the children help to pack their own bags so that when they arrive at Lea Green they know what they have with them. Remember it is better to have too much than not enough – however they will have to take their bags upstairs to their bedroom!

Kit - to be packed in a suitcase

- Waterproof coat/jacket
- Sunhat/suncream
- Old tracksuit bottoms, t-shirt and top(these are likely to get muddy!)
- A change of clothes
- Pyjamas/ night clothes
- Flannel,/ soap or wipes and handtowel (hopefully no-one will need a shower!)

- Outdoor shoes/ walking boots/trainers
- Indoor PE kit and plimsolls. Please don't only pack slippers.
- Plastic bag to put muddy clothes in
- Underwear and socks
- Toothbrush and toothpaste.
- No earrings please.

Please arrive at school at the normal time Thursday25th May, as we will not be leaving until 10am. Please come dressed in clothes ready for Lea Green- no need for children to wear school uniform for this residential trip. All children will also need to bring a packed lunch to eat as soon as we arrive, so please ensure your child has this with them in the morning. If your child requires any medication to be administered whilst we are on residential please fill in the medicine form (available from the school office/foyer) and hand to your child's class teacher along with the medicine on the morning of Thursday 25th May.

We are expected to return before the end of Friday 26th May, however if this does change due to traffic, then tweets and texts will be sent to keep you updated. We will be posting tweets regularly so you can see the fun the children are having whilst there.
