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Dear parents,

The Year 3 and 4 teachers have been putting together a programme of home learning activities to begin from Wednesday of this week. These are attached to this email, as soon as the new school website is live we will upload home learning plans and resources there, hopefully that will be really soon.

Each day there will be English, Maths and topic activities; these will include a variety of different types of activity including online, paper based and a few that may require printing if possible (we have tried to make this optional where possible). The weekly overview will be emailed or uploaded by 8.30am each Monday.

The majority of Maths activities will be using an online platform called MyMaths. To access this, you will need the whole school login (below).

MyMaths school login:

Go to www.mymaths.co.uk and login at the top of the page with the school's username and password.

The school username is: scargill1 The school password is: triangle145

On the next page your child should enter their personal username and password in the My Portal box. All the year 3 and 4 children have practiced doing this in school during the Autumn term. For the MyMaths activities there are 2 options; 'Try the lesson' and 'Start homework', Children should work through 'Try the lesson' first as this will go through the skills and knowledge necessary for the homework task. On the overview we have stated which task to complete each day and these will appear on the homework list, you may need to scroll right or left to find the tasks. Click 'Mark It' when you have completed the task to hand it in so your teacher can see it.

Logins

Your child should have login details for the following: Purple Mash, MyMaths, TTRockstars/Numbots, Epic, Oxford Owl, Imoves and, for some children, Nessy. If they do not know these logins please get in touch via the department email address. Oxford Owl and Imoves have been sent via Purple Mash email earlier today.

Face-to-face meetings

Each day we will be holding a face-to-face video call with the children via Zoom, during this time we may do some teaching input for one of the day's activities, read a story together, do a quiz or share a worship time. These will start from next week. We will share Zoom codes, passwords and times as soon as possible.
