Timings

Clothing

Please wear clothes suitable for outdoor activities e.g. leggings, jogging bottoms, jumper and trainers. Shorts are OK if they are comfortable for lots of activity! Ideal clothing on top would be a t-shirt (with sleeves and covered shoulders), a hoodie (e.g. leaver's hoodie) or jumper, then a waterproof coat/cagoule. Please try to avoid jeans as they will be extremely slow to dry and uncomfortable if they get wet. We will encourage your child to take their PE kit home today if they need jogging bottoms or trainers from it.

Things to bring

- Lunch and snacks
- Water (2 bottles would be good; can be refilled during the day)
- Waterproof coat
- Sun cream (fingers crossed for a sunny day)

- Sun hat
- A small backpack to put everything in
- Fleece or jumper

What not to bring

- Money (there's no shop!)
- Phones (as usual children are not allowed phones)
- Camera (we will take lots of photos to share on website/Twitter!)
