On Wednesday, we'd like you to complete the- headline, subheading and first paragraph- explaining about all 5Ws in brief detail.

On Thursday you need to continue writing your report- additional information, expert quotes, what will happen next and complete the WILF below, thinking about the features we looked at in newspaper reports.
