What we have planned for the children...

In Spring 1 our theme is People who help us. We learn about a variety of people including the police service, fire service, vets, mountain rescue and sea rescue. Through these sessions we teach the equipment, how they work and how they help us. In maths we will be looking at number bonds for the numbers 2 to 5 and exploring different types of addition as our main focal points. In our literacy sessions we will be using our theme to guide our texts as we use books such as 'Cops and Robbers' and 'Charlie the Firefighter' to aid our writing.

Some key information and updates:

Staffing: In January we will be very lucky to have both Mrs Chisholm and Mr Askew still as part of our team for a transitionary period of time. We feel this will really help the children to have a smooth transition.
