Dear Parent and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well as we begin to take further steps back to 'normal'. We have updated our risk assessment and a link to it on our website will be sent out shortly.

**The following changes have been made in relation to measures and guidance for managing COVID-19 in education and childcare settings with effect from 1 April 2022:**

- Pupils who are unwell and have a high temperature should self-isolate. They should return to school when they no longer have a high temperature and are well enough to attend.
- Adults with a positive test should isolate for 5 days.
- Pupils with a positive test should isolate for 3 days.
- There will be no LFT testing at the end of self-isolation.
- No test kits can be given out to staff, pupils or families

Data sheets will be coming home with your child this week. If you have any questions regarding these, please don't hesitate to contact us.

I want to thank parents for their continued support. Covid continues to have an impact on staffing and we are working hard to keep planned activities in place this week.
