## **NEW SCHOOL MENU**

After the Easter holidays , the school menu will change to the Spring/Summer 2023 one. As you can see, there is a new layout, with various new options. A copy of the menu will come home with children before Easter.

Here is how this new menu will work:

- **Option 1:** This is the main meal served that day and available to everyone who orders a school dinner.
- Option 2:This is usually the vegetarian option, unless the main meal is<br/>vegetarian. Limited amount.<br/>This needs to be pre-ordered to guarantee availability.
- Pasta Option:Hot Pasta Option. Limited amount.This needs to be pre-ordered to guarantee availability.

To pre-order a meal, please either call or email the school office (contacts above), the day before or in the morning (before 9.30am), to let us know.

As always, Reception, Years 1 & 2 receive Universal Free School meals (UIFSM). From Year 3 upwards, the current cost of a meal is £2.30 or £11.50 per week, unless you are in receipt of Pupil Premium Free School meals (FSM).

If you think you may qualify for Free School Meals, even if your child has UIFSM, please contact the school office for further information. **Remember that Free School Meals are a statutory right and it is important that you use it if you qualify, your child will then receive a school meal each day.** Additional information and an application form can be found on the Derbyshire County Council's website or in the school office if you do not have access to the internet: http://www.derbyshire.gov.uk/education/schools/your child at school/meals/school <u>meals/default.asp?VD=freeschoolmeals</u>
