You will have the opportunity to ask questions and get advice about keeping your children safe online. We think this is particularly important as, since the start of the pandemic, children are spending more time learning and playing online than ever before.

Traci says “Firstly, and most importantly this isn’t a session to tell you how to parent your children! As parents and carers we need to understand some of the risks our children face and how we can support them, and where we can get help ourselves if we need it. Children are making and sharing their own content online from a very young age, using apps like YouTube, TikTok, Twitch and Roblox and often we feel left behind, or unsure around things like screen time.
