WALT: practise writing newspaper headlines.

Today we'd like you to practise writing newspaper headlines. Think about the headlines of the articles you've looked at this week, and look at the powerpoint on writing headlines. Then have a go at the activity- read the story summary and come up with a headline for the story.

If you really fancy a challenge, think about how the headline could be different for a different audience or newspaper- are all newspapers the same? You could even find out which newspapers tend to have more formal-language headlines and which tend to have more informal/pun-based headlines and think of headlines dependent on which paper they could be for.
